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
















DAY: 2: GROUP GATHER/ FOOD FEST:



International paper bag day

12th July, 2023

World Paper Bag Day is celebrated annually to promote the importance of utilizing paper bags instead of plastic. This observance serves as a reminder to prioritize environmentally conscious choices in our everyday lives and encourages individuals and businesses to adopt more sustainable alternatives. The first version of the paper bag, invented by Francis Wolle in the early 1850s, was an envelope-shaped bag, which was limited in terms of its durability and amount of interior space. In 1870, Margaret **Knight** designed machine to cut, fold and paste paper bag bottoms. This meant that she could produce flat/square-bottomed paper bags, a great improvement on the earlier envelope-style bag design.



President Science College has organized one day workshop for B.Sc. students for making Paper bags from the old newspaper. The workshop was supported by Dr. Shivangi Mathur, organized by Dr. Hetal and Dr. Juhi Gajjar, and managed by Ms. Megha Lodha and Ms. Ritika Yadav. The theme of World Paper Bag Day 2023 is 'If You're 'Fantastic', Do Something

percent of tigers had disappeared in the past century, with only about 3,000 remaining. International Tiger Day is celebrated annually on July 29. The tiger enjoys the reputation of being the largest of the world's big cats. A tiger can be easily identified with its distinctive orange and black stripes on

its face and body. Il the early 80s, there were tigers in Gujarat, mainly inhabiting the forests of Dang, Narmada and Sabarkantha districts. The last tiger died in a road accident in Dang in 1985. No tiger was seen in the state after that.

The Tiger Population in India 2023 is 3,167. On the 50th year of Project Tiger in India. The tiger reserves of India were set up in 1973 and are governed under Project Tiger, which is administrated by the National Tiger Conservation Authority, Government of India. Tiger reserves were designated in 50 protected areas until 2018. In 2022, the 53rd tiger reserve was declared in Ranipur Wildliffe Sanctuary, Uttar Pradesh, and the State's third tiger reserve.

India is home to 80 percent of tigers in the world. In 2006, India estimated that there were 1,411 tigers which doubled to 3167 in 2022.








Seminar on "Nanotechnology and Nanometrial"








Structure Preparation


"Science Manthan 2024"
















"Science Manthan 2024"




Hands-on Session"Plant


